### **GARCIA RE-ELECTED PRESIDENT OF ROCKY FLATS MUSEUM**

Rocky Flats Cold War Museum officers for 2010 are Shirley Garcia of Broomfield, president; Phil Saba of Arvada, vice-president; Susan Flack of Boulder, secretary; and Doug Parker of Arvada, treasurer. Garcia and Parker were re-elected after serving one term.

Garcia, who worked at the Rocky Flats Nuclear Weapons Plant from 1982-97, now works for Broomfield's Environmental Services Division. A former board vice-president, she chairs the Education Committee. Phil Saba, president of the Homesteaders, the Rocky Flats retiree group, joined the board in May.

Flack, a new board member, has more than 20 years of experience in environmental exposure and risk analysis, dose reconstruction and risk communication at nuclear facilities including Rocky Flats. She serves on the Education Committee. Parker retired from Rocky Flats after 23 years and now works part-time for Boulder County's Household Hazardous Waste Unit.
